Probably the most dramatic example of the UFO/ET historical evidence is to be found in the modern day myth and culture of the HOPI Indians in Arizona, USA.

## and their heritage

**T**hroughout the recorded history of a majority of North and South American Indian cultures we find firm and convincing evidence of UFOs and Extraterrestrial visitations and influences in the form of tribal legends, religious mythology, ancient writings, pictographs, petroglyphs, cave and wall paintings, ceremonial dances and pageantry and their day-to-day practices and beliefs.

Present day HOPIs regard themselves as the first real inhabitants of America. They believe that the ancient HOPI legends clearly established HOPI settlement at Old Oraibi, Arizona, about 150 miles northeast of Prescott.

The first HOPIs were guided to this sacred site by a "bright star"... a star which Dan Katchongva, the late Chief of the HOPIs and his followers now say

was a "flying saucer craft" piloted by "Kachinas," the demigods of the HOPI religion.

In accordance with the ancient sacred HOPI prophecy of "Purification Day," they were directed by the great spirit "Maasau" who placed in the hands of the peaceful HOPI, a set of stone tablets, "Tiponi," a symbol of power and authority.

These stone tablets contained much wisdom and knowledge

about the past, present and future of the HOPI people. It is also widely believed and accepted by the HOPI that another set of sacred stone tablets will be delivered to them at the Day of Purification, soon to come. On that day, according to Mrs. Tawangyawma, a HOPI spokeswoman, "We know the (HOPI) faithful are to be gathered to escape the perils of Purification Day." The HOPIs also know that



other planets and worlds exist? that there are other people in the heavens and that they are watching us.

At that time, nearly 23 years ago, the traditionalist leaders of Hotevilla and other HOPI settlements clearly interpreted the numerous UFO sightings as a positive physical sign that the ancient HOPI prophecy of Purification Day was indeed very near at hand. Planetary time for the HOPIs stands still; their culture and traditions are timeless in value and perspective.

Keep in mind that the HOPI Indians (from the word "Hopitu-shinumu," meaning Peaceful People), throughout their long and colorful history have lived up to the meaning of their name. The HOPIs have long existed as a nation of unified people, probably as far back as the 13th century, living throughout the vast valleys and tablelands of the great Southwestern United States and Mexico.

The HOPI belong to the Uto-Aztecan language family, though the HOPI in the village of Hano, curiously enough, speak Tewa. The founders of Hano were Rio Grande Pueblos fleeing their ancient home under Spanish pressure to seek refuge among the Peaceful ones.

As early as 1540 they were visited by some of Coronado's men under the leadership of Captain Pedro de Tovar, but because of their geographical isolation, they remained more independent of white Spanish influence than the other Pueblo tribes. At this time in their history their population, with the Zuni, was estimated to be between 3,000 to 4,000. In 1629 a Roman Catholic mission was established at the pueblo of Awatobi, but because of the rebellion of 1680 the early missionaries fled. Later, the Indians of this pueblo invited the missionaries to return, and this so infuriated the other HOPI that they destroyed Awatobi. Further missionary efforts were opposed

until more recent times and Oraibi is the only one of the pueblos which has remained on the same site since 1540.

The first revelation of the HOPI's historical and religious world-view of life traces their original lineage and tribal wanderings to comprise most of the root stocks for North and South American Indian tribes. The oldest HOPI tribal traditions trace their history in Arizona back more than 2,000 years, and their historical perspective as a people back many more thousands of years. The HOPI may well be direct or even distant descendants of the more ancient Anasazi, who themselves claim their origin from the "star people."

HOPI prophecies contain colorful and poignant references to the "inner city" called Palatkwapi or the "inner earth city" with reports of secret openings or passageways leading inward/downward to the "inner earth" located throughout the Grand Canyon area of Northwestern Arizona. The oldest legends contend that their forefathers who built the "inner earth city" of Palatkwapi, came from the distant Pleiades. The inhabitants who reportedly live in this city are humanoid type beings some seven feet tall with blonde hair and blue eyes and who have small holes in the middle of their foreheads (containing their third-eye). Further reports contend that these people travel freely within their "inner earthworld" in special flying machines (sic-flying saucer craft). Much of the HOPI and other Native American Indian legend and myth material has been found and gathered from thousands of well-preserved petroglyphs scattered throughout the Southwestern United States.

Given the reality of the HOPI forecast for the forthcoming Purification Day and the removal of the HOPI faithful, the biblical prophecies contained within the Book of Revelation coincide perfectly with the HOPI's apocalyp-

tical cleansing of the planet Earth during its final tribulation period. The "rapture theme," a hotly debated perspective viewed and interpreted in the New Testament by a growing number of Christians, relies heavily upon a similar theme of spiritual purification and the sudden disappearance (Matthew 24:27-44) of the true believers from the planet's surface to meet the Lord in the Heavens.

One of the greatest unsolved questions of all time and antiquity is the unexplained and utter disappearance of several of the oldest Central and South American Native Indian cultures from the face of the Earth.

The Anasazi, Aztecs, Mayans, and Toltecs are but a few of these mysterious lost tribes and all that remains of their presence are the ancient and crumbling monuments of their past glory and grandeur. Only their cities, temples, pyramids and celestial observatories of stone remain, a lasting and magnificent tribute to an architecture, science of mind and religious culture lost to the stars forever.

A great many of the oldest Indian legends from both North and South American Indian cultures foretell of a same or similar tale, one of a forthcoming "day of atonement," the great "day of judgment" and the most similar of all pronouncements, the long awaited Day of Purification.

The numerous Arizona "flying saucer" sightings in HOPI land occurred primarily during August and September 1970. This was also an unusual period for the UFO sightings in much of the country and over large segments of the globe. The HOPI elders believe that the saucer sightings signaled the last of the warnings and that the Purification Day will surely come within the present generation of the HOPI people.

Those poignant prophecies are based upon the belief that the true HOPI origin can be traced to a mystifying cluster of distant

suns in the heavens. The Pleiades, often called The Seven Sisters. The HOPI have named them "Choo ho kan," meaning...those that cling together. They join many other native Indian cultures disbursed around the world, all claiming a common bond between themselves (as nations of people) and the direct descendants of the inhabitants of The Pleiadian Connection...the true HOPI "Home."

Further evidence of the HOPI prophecy coming true is the massive increase of violent cataclysm's of natural causes. Thousands of new earthquakes, violent land and sea storms, volcanic eruptions, famines, aberrant ocean currents and unexpected bizarre weather patterns occurring planet-wide are now a fact. Collectively they bear witness to the all too familiar "end time" purification scenario quoted time and time again in the oldest of the apocryphal writings and literature of the ancient cultures.

Whether we believe in UFOs and ETs is not the point. The end result of our belief or disbelief in this phenomenon is all that matters. That ultimate conclusion and its futuristic consequences for mankind will soon become manifest as our planet shifts from one dimension plane of reality to another. All indicators say Earth's universal space-time-continuum will soon undergo a major recycling, a transformation process, the Day of Purification.

As the HOPI and many other Indian traditions and world religions prophecy, this event will forever change the complexity, nature and destiny of our world. Will the ETs return to the HOPI and other Indian nations of the Earth to return their children of the stars home. Will God also return to gather up his righteous flock. Are UFOs and ETs truth or fiction? The truth of the Extraterrestrial hypothesis may soon be exposed.

Let's hope that this truth, whatever it be, proves mightier than the sword, the HOPIs do.
